




Grid Electrical Overview

Grid is now at the forefront of providing integrated building services for the design, installation, and ongoing maintenance in all aspects of the electrical industry.




HSEQ



Liverpool Hospital Health & Academic Precinct Project

Description: The Liverpool Health and Academic Precinct includes clinical and non-clinical services infrastructure to expand, enhance and optimise current capacity at Liverpool Hospital. The Project will be delivered across 2 stages

- Stage 1 Main works will include redevelopment of the hospitals main entrance, maternity services, outpatient and support service, including a new pathology department and expanded emergency department.
- Stage 2 main works will include construction of a new integrated services building with outpatient clinics, inpatient units, a Wellness Centre and loading dock.
- The \$790 million Liverpool Hospital development is due to be completed in 2026.



Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital Redevelopment – Stage 2 and 2A

This is the second Stage of the Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Hospital Redevelopment and follows on from the already constructed Stage 1 work also completed by GRiD Electrical Services. It includes the addition of pharmacy, mortuary, ambulatory care, expansion of ED, pediatrics, combined intense care & high dependency unit, cardiology, rehabilitation, inpatient units, medical imaging, helipad, education and research with support services and retail. The \$265 million Hornsby Hospital development is due to be completed in November 2022.


